Credentialing Exam Pass Rate (Diploma)

Five-year averages of the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) credentialing examination pass rate not less than 75% at first attempt within six months of graduation

Year	Pass Rate <i>First Attempt within 6 months of graduation</i>	Number of Graduates
2009	70%	7 out of 10 graduates passed on 1st attempt
2010	90%	9 out of 10 graduates passed on 1st attempt
2011	75%	3 out of 4 graduates passed on 1st attempt
2012	100%	6 out of 6 graduates passed on 1st attempt
2013	92%	11 out of 12 graduates passed on 1st attempt
5 Year Average	86%	36 out of 42 graduates passed on 1st attempt

Note: The cohort graduating spring 2014 marks the first graduating class of the associate degree terminal award. Previous cohorts received a diploma as the terminal award. The following reflects the most current data available for the terminal award of associate degree at this time.
