2. How to view if we are missing information from you.

- Log into BannerWeb
- Select "Student & Financial Aid"
- Select "Financial Aid & Authorizations"
- Select "My Eligibility for Financial Aid"
- Select "Student Requirements"
- Review list of missing documents
- Select "Additional Documents Required"
 - * Will only be present if additional documents are needed
 - *May be asked to create a Financial Aid Services Account. This is a one-time account creation used to validate your identity for electronic signatures on forms.
- Select "Create Account Link
- Enter/confirm student information
- Select "Create Account"
- Review, complete, & upload unsatisfied requirements

3. I've registered for classes. Now what do I do? Once you have registered for your classes, you can view your actual bill and financial aid awards for the semester by following the steps below.

- Log into BannerWeb
- Select "Student & Financial Aid"
- Select "Financial Aid & Authorizations"
- Select "My Financial Aid Award Information"
- Select "My Account Detail by Term"
- Select the Term

A negative amount listed next to "Account Balance Net of Authorized Financial Aid and Memos" is the amount of PELL and/or loans that is available to be used in the Bookstore.

After all tuition, fees, & bookstore charges, this amount is the amount of your refund check(s) for the term.

A positive amount indicates that a balance is owed to the college.

• Select "Pay Now" to pay outstanding balance

4. How to view your College Financing Plan by following these steps below.

- Log into BannerWeb
- Select "Student & Financial Aid"
- Select "Financial Aid & Authorizations"
- Select "Federal Shopping Sheet"
- View and/or download your College Financing Plan

*This is **only an estimate of your awards and expenses**. <u>Your actual awards and charges</u> are based on your registration, standing, program of study, and eligibility.

5. How to view if you have an award letter.

- · Log into BannerWeb
- Select "Student & Financial Aid"
- Select "Financial Aid & Authorizations"
- Select "My Financial Aid Award Information"
- Select "Award for Aid Year"
- Select "Award Overview" tab
- Review and/or print your award letter

*This is **only an estimate of your awards**. <u>Your actual awards are based on your registration, standing, program of study, and eligibility.</u>

6. Am I eligible for a financial aid refund after all of my tuition, fees, and book expenses have been paid?

- If you have a **negative balance**, then you <u>may</u> be eligible for a refund. (*See #3)
- Refunds will be issued by check as listed on the STC Academic Calendar for each term.
